Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how CT Eco Plus Limited collects, uses, stores, protects and shares personal information in accordance with UK GDPR, the Data Protection Act 2018 and other applicable legislation.

CT Eco Plus Limited provides services relating to the Energy Company Obligation (ECO) scheme and associated energy efficiency programmes. This policy applies to visitors to our websites, customers, installers, partners and other individuals whose personal data we process.

Definitions

UK GDPR means the United Kingdom General Data Protection Regulation. **ICO** means the Information Commissioner's Office. **Personal Data** means information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.

Personal Data We Collect

Name, contact details, address information, property information, survey information, evidence documents, photographs, communications, technical installation information and records required to administer ECO and related schemes.

Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal data on the basis of consent, contract, legal obligation and legitimate interests, depending upon the nature of the relationship and services provided.

Processing and Sharing Personal Data

We use personal data to administer services, communicate with customers and partners, undertake compliance activities, prevent fraud, manage contractual relationships and comply with legal obligations. Data may be shared with approved processors, energy suppliers, auditors, compliance bodies, regulators, IT providers and professional advisers where necessary.

Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Automated Processing

CT Eco Plus may utilise Artificial Intelligence (AI), machine learning technologies and automated analytical tools to assess evidence, review documents, analyse data, identify anomalies, support compliance checks, improve operational efficiency and enhance service delivery. AI systems are used as decision-support tools and are subject to appropriate human oversight. Significant decisions affecting individuals are not made solely through automated processing unless permitted by law. Where third-party AI providers are used, contractual and technical safeguards are implemented to protect personal data.

Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil legal, contractual and regulatory requirements. Retention periods relating to ECO obligations may extend beyond general enquiry retention periods.

International Transfers

Where personal data is transferred outside the United Kingdom, appropriate safeguards will be implemented in accordance with UK GDPR requirements.

Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, loss or destruction.

Data Breach Response

In the event of a personal data breach, CT Eco Plus will investigate the incident, mitigate risks, notify affected parties where required and report relevant breaches to the ICO within applicable statutory timescales.

Your Rights

You have the right to be informed, access your data, rectify inaccurate information, request erasure, restrict processing, object to processing, request portability and not be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing where applicable.
